Guidelines for Campers

We want everyone to enjoy their time at the 'Life on the Holme Front' weekend and to go home in the same condition they arrived in.

A camping steward will be on site in a prominent position for the duration of the event and emergency contact numbers are provided below for your reference. All rules and guidelines on site have been put in place for the safety of all patrons and conform to current Health & Safety requirements.

Our Camping Marshall will site your pitch within the legal distance of surrounding pitches. Your co-operation in this matter is greatly appreciated.

Please take the time to familiarise yourself with the following guidelines to ensure our campsite remains a happy, pleasant place to stay:

- Please respect the residents of the village; this will help to ensure we have no complaints and are welcomed back in the future!
- If you have a generator for your camper van or tent, please make sure it is switched off by **10.00pm** to avoid disturbing other campers and nearby village residents.
- A Portaloo facility is available for use on the campsite as well as a standpipe, to ensure all campers have access to running water during their stay.
- All dogs **must** be kept on a lead at all times and all dog fouling must be cleared away immediately. Appropriate bins are located around the site and village for this purpose.
- The use of charcoal and/or ground barbeques is **prohibited** – raised, gas BBQs only please.
- Please protect your area from any oil/grease from vehicles or BBQs, especially on tarmacked areas. If you would like to use a BBQ, please ensure you have the relevant Fire Safety precautions with you. Most importantly, **never** use your BBQ inside your tent or awning.
- Due to the close proximity of farmland, the use of Chinese lanterns is **strictly** prohibited.
- Wherever possible, please **practice low-impact camping**. This includes respecting the natural environment, protecting area plants and vegetation, avoiding the disturbance of nearby animals, properly disposing of all waste and leaving the campsite as you found it.
- The site will be returned to livestock grazing after the event, so please ensure that **all** rubbish has been removed before you leave. Bins are located around the site and village for this purpose. Alternatively, you can take your rubbish home with you, but please refrain from emptying waste water of any kind into surrounding hedgerows. An Elsan facility is situated on site for this purpose.
